

## IMPORTANT NOTES

Failure to install product according to installation instructions will result in loss of warranty. Actual configuration may vary. When moving Neighborhood modular units, lift base and move into position. Never lift unit using privacy wall or drag unit across floor.

## Connecting Modules

Unpack Neighborhood modules and move into the desired location.

Level front-to-back and side-to-side by adjusting the height of the glides located on the underside of the module. (See Diagram 1)

Rotate the connector forks so that they are perpendicular to the module. (See Diagram 2)

Align the units so the connector forks will fit around the bracket plates. (See Diagram 3)

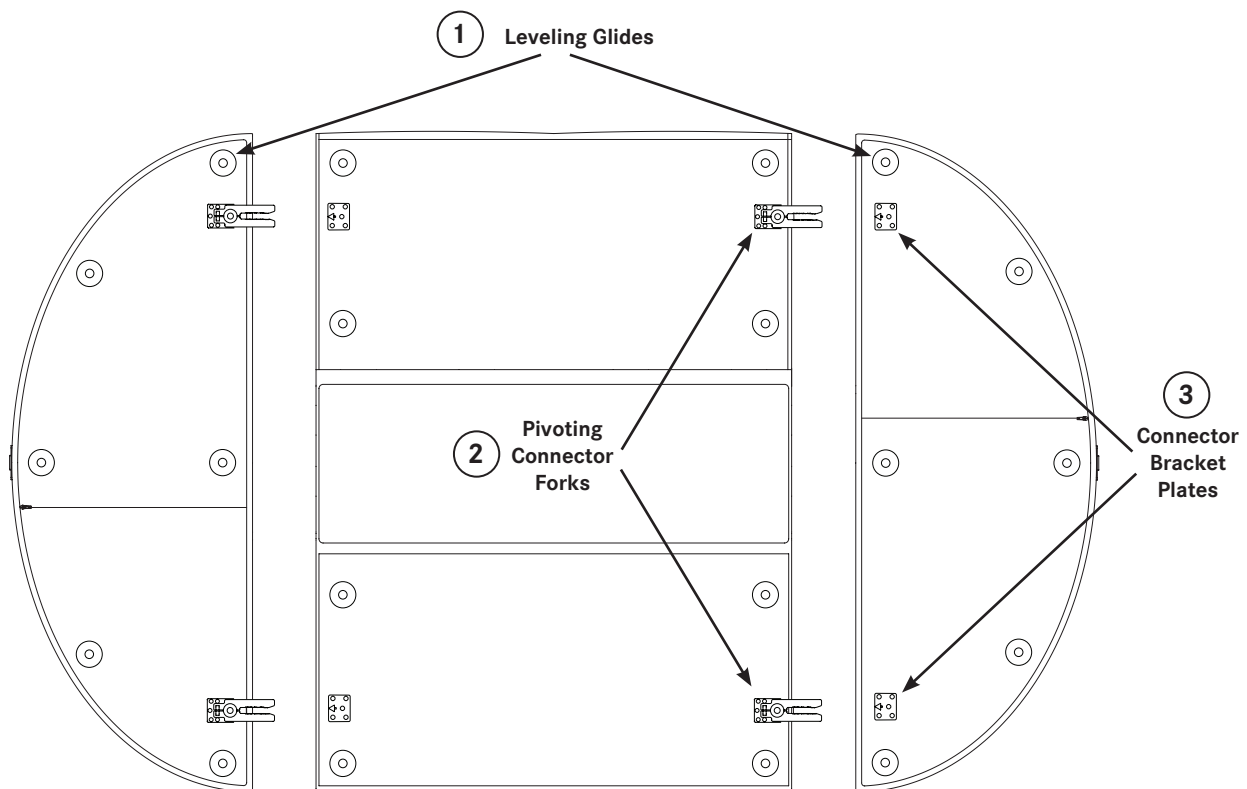
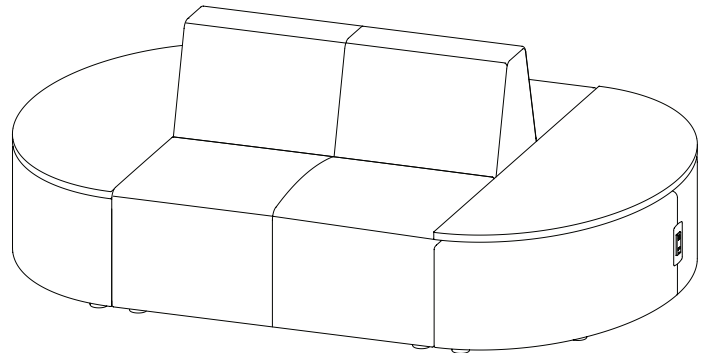
With a person on each side of the modular grouping, slide the units together.

To disconnect modules, lift the side of the module where the bracket plates are located, generally the left hand facing side.

Pull to disconnect the brackets from the connecting forks and slide apart.

Modules used in configurations may also be used as freestanding units. The connector fork can be concealed by rotating the connecting fork underneath the furniture module.

Hardware is provided with the 180° curved module for left or right hand orientation.
